

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Bids for construction of the 2009-2010 Check Structures and Zillah Wasteway Structure, addressed to Sunnyside Division Board of Control, 120 South 11th Street, Sunnyside, WA 98944, will be received at the office of the Sunnyside Valley Irrigation District, City of Sunnyside, State of Washington, (Owner), until 1:30 p.m., local time, on the August 31, 2009. Any Bids received after the specified time will not be considered.

Bids will then be publicly opened and read.

The Project contemplated consists of construction of five reinforced concrete check structures and one wasteway structure. Prior to the Contractor beginning Work at a check structure, the Owner will install the sheet piling cutoff wall. After the Contractor completes his Work, the Owner will install gates, metal work, and electrical and control systems at all check structures. Owner will install electrical and control systems at wasteway structure. Further descriptions of the schedule for Work are available in Section 01010, Summary of Work. The anticipated construction cost is between \$650,000 and \$900,000. The 2009-2010 Check Structure and Zillah Wasteway Structure Drawings, Specifications, addendums (if any), and other information can be found at www.svid.org.

The Contractor's Work will be completed in all respects on or before January 29, 2010.

Bidding Documents may be examined in Owner's office, 120 South 11th Street, Sunnyside, WA. Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Owner's office upon payment (check or money order only) of \$50 for each set of documents. Return of the documents is not required and the amount paid for the documents is nonrefundable.

To obtain Bidding Documents via mail, send requests to the attention of Ms. Theresa Johnson at the office of the Owner. Include a check or money order in the amount noted.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed Bid Form and accompanied by Bid security as prescribed in the Instructions to Bidders.

The Successful Bidder will be required to furnish the additional bond(s) prescribed in the Bidding Documents and be required to sign two documents: the Non-Collusion and Debarment Affidavit, and the Anti-Discrimination Certificate as bound in the Bidding Documents.

In order to submit a Bid on public work, Bidders and their Subcontractors shall hold such licenses and registrations as required by State Statutes and Codes, and federal and local Laws and Regulations.
