PUBLIC NOTICE

The Sunnyside Valley Irrigation District (SVID) will be applying aquatic weed herbicides to its irrigation canals, laterals, and drains from May 20 through January 30, 2015 in accordance with Washington Department of Ecology Permit No. WAG-991000.

The applications will be made to a majority of the irrigation facilities within the SVID boundaries in Yakima and Benton Counties.

The proposed herbicides and their active ingredients to control vegetative growth are: Cascade, Dipotassium Salt of Endothall; Teton, Mono (N, N-Dimethyl Alkylamine) Salt of Endothall; Nautique, Copper Ethylenediamine Complex and Copper Triethanolamine Complex; Captain* Algaecide, Copper Ethanolamine Complex; Sonar, Fluridone (non-irrigation season); and MAGNACIDE® H Herbicide, Acrolein. It is the responsibility of the landowner to deny treated water to their land and/or livestock.

Application sites will be posted with the name and telephone number of SVID. Treatments are posted at www.svid.org. Waters within SVID are intended for agricultural purposes only and are not for human consumption or primary contact such as swimming or aquaculture. Irrigation facilities can be dangerous, are not for public use, and intended only for operation and maintenance personnel.
