

## **SUNNYSIDE DIVISION BOARD OF CONTROL REQUESTS PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

The Sunnyside Division Board of Control requests Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) from engineering firms with demonstrated expertise in design and construction management related to re-regulating reservoirs within a large canal system. The successful firm will 1) locate a suitable site 2) prepare construction documents and 3) have construction management responsibility for implementing this project. The reservoir to be constructed must work within an existing automated canal system that currently has 3 reservoirs and 30 check structures all connected to a SCADA system.

SOQs should be submitted by interested parties not later than April 18, 2024. 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The reservoir is expected to be located between Grandview and Prosser along the Sunnyside Canal and range in size between 400 and 600 acre-feet. A minimum of 50 acres will need to be acquired to accommodate the reservoir and provide a suitable borrow site. The project will take place between the summer of 2024 and the summer of 2027 with site scoping, evaluation, and property securing occurring during the first year, property purchase and design the second year, and construction during the third year. Total estimated construction cost is expected to be \$10,000,000. One or more firms will be selected from the SOQs received or on file at the SVID office for further discussion and preliminary project scoping prior to final selection.

- 2) Preferred length less than 20 pages
- 3) Present key members of the design team with assigned office location
- 4) Present experience with similar projects completed (include references)
