

MEETING OF THE SUNNYSIDE DIVISION
BOARD OF CONTROL

The regular meeting of the Sunnyside Division Board of Control (SDBOC) was held in-person and via conference call and was called to order by Chairman Simpson on March 10, 2026, at 1:30 PM. Present in addition to Chairman Simpson was Director Kevin Golob, Paul Groeneweg, Markus Rollinger and Will Scarlett; David Felman, SDBOC Secretary/Treasurer, Ron Cowin, Assistant Manager- Engineering, Nikki Musson, SDBOC Deputy Treasurer/Office Manager and Dave Bos, Assistant Manager-Operations. Norman Semanko, Legal Counsel for the Sunnyside Division Board of Control and Director Mike Hogue participated virtually. Also in attendance was Chris Jensen, SVID landowner.

The minutes of the February 3, 2026, Board Meeting were reviewed. Upon a motion by Director Golob, that was seconded and unanimously carried, the minutes were approved.

The Board reviewed the monthly financial reports and vouchers numbered 6727-6768 in the total amount of \$537,024.56 which were submitted for approval. A motion was made by Director Groeneweg which was seconded and unanimously carried, authorizing payment of the vouchers as listed above.

Ms. Musson presented the 2025 draft year-end financials for SDBOC. The year-end financials will be filed with the Washington State Auditor’s Office on or before May 31st.

Mr. Bos presented the water supply report. As of March 10, 2026, storage in the mountain reservoirs is at 827,879 acre-feet or 75% of capacity. Storage content is 128% of average. Precipitation for the year to date (Oct 1 to Mar 10) is 177.27 inches or 106% of average. Snowpack is 41% of average for the period of October 1st through March 10th. The March pro-rationing set by the Bureau of Reclamation is 44% supply to prorated water rights.

Mr. Bos presented the priming schedule for Board approval with priming to begin on March 18, 2026. A motion was made by Director Golob which was seconded, and unanimously carried, approving the beginning of the 2026 water season on Wednesday, March 18th.

The provided dates for priming the laterals are as follows:

Head Gate	Wednesday March 18, 2026
Lower Division	Friday March 20, 2026
Snipes Lateral, Mabton	Monday March 23, 2026
30.20, 23.10, 39.79 and 48.04	Tuesday March 24, 2026
Prosser, 49.71 and others as needed	Wednesday March 25, 2026

Mr. Cowin updated the Board on ELIPS. The 26/27 ELIPS landowner letters were mailed out in early February with a meeting held on March 3, 2026. Six landowners attended the meeting, during which the 27.69 and 52.90 lateral piping projects were discussed.

Mr. Felman asked the Board for authorization to consolidate bank accounts that have not been used since 2012. These three accounts would be consolidated into the SDBOC main account. Upon a motion by Director Scarlett, which was seconded and unanimously carried, the Board authorized consolidation of the three unused accounts into the primary SDBOC account.


