

MEETING OF THE SUNNYSIDE DIVISION  
BOARD OF CONTROL

The regular meeting of the Sunnyside Division Board of Control (SDBOC) was held in-person and via conference call and was called to order by Chairman Doug Simpson on May 5, 2026, at 1:30 PM. Present in addition to Chairman Simpson was Director Kevin Golob, Paul Groeneweg, and Will Scarlett; David Felman, SDBOC Secretary/Treasurer, Ron Cowin, Assistant Manager- Engineering, and Nikki Musson, SVID Deputy Treasurer/Office Manager. Norman Semanko, Legal Counsel for the Sunnyside Division Board of Control and Director Mike Hogue participated virtually.

The minutes of the April 7, 2026, Board Meeting were reviewed. Upon a motion by Director Golob, that was seconded and unanimously carried, the minutes were approved.

The Board reviewed the monthly financial reports and vouchers numbered 6798-6815 in the total amount of \$355,306.79 which were submitted for approval. A motion was made by Director Golob which was seconded and unanimously carried, authorizing payment of the vouchers as listed above.


Mr. Felman presented the water supply report. As of May 5, 2026, storage in the mountain reservoirs is at 1,026,109 acre-feet or 96% of capacity. Storage content is 125.5% of average. Precipitation for the year to date (Oct 1 to May 5) is 231.75 inches or 117% of average. Snowpack is 23% of average for the period of October 1<sup>st</sup> through May 5<sup>th</sup>. The April pro-rationing set by the Bureau of Reclamation is 52% supply to prorated water rights. SDBOC is currently diverting 640cfs.

Mr. Cowin updated the Board on ELIPS. The deadline for landowners to purchase flowmeters was May 1, 2026. A total of 24 flowmeters were sold. With the completion of flowmeter purchases, engineering will now finish the pipe design and start preparing the pipe bid ahead of the June board meeting.

Mr. Felman reported that the joint delivery call letter was sent to the Department of Ecology electronically on Friday May 1, 2026 followed by a press release. An initial response acknowledging acceptance was received, but no formal response has been received from Ecology yet.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 1:45 PM.
