

MEETING OF THE SUNNYSIDE DIVISION
BOARD OF CONTROL

The regular meeting of the Sunnyside Division Board of Control (SDBOC) was held in-person and via conference call and was called to order by Chairman Doug Simpson on June 9, 2026, at 1:30 PM. Present in addition to Chairman Simpson was Director Paul Groeneweg, Markus Rollinger, Mike Hogue, and Will Scarlett; David Felman, SDBOC Secretary/Treasurer, Ron Cowin, Assistant Manager- Engineering, Dave Bos, Assistant Manager-Operations, and Nikki Musson, SVID Deputy Treasurer/Office Manager. Norman Semanko, Legal Counsel for the Sunnyside Division Board of Control, participated virtually.

The minutes of the May 5, 2026, Board Meeting were reviewed. Upon a motion by Director Hogue, that was seconded and unanimously carried, the minutes were approved.

The Board reviewed the monthly financial reports and vouchers numbered 6816-6825 in the total amount of \$191,111.46 which were submitted for approval. A motion was made by Director Hogue which was seconded and unanimously carried, authorizing payment of the vouchers as listed above.

Mr. Bos presented the water supply report. As of June 9, 2026, storage in the mountain reservoirs is at 962,510 acre-feet or 90% of capacity. Storage content is 99.5% of average. Precipitation for the year to date (Oct 1 to June 9) is 238.73 inches or 115% of average. Snowpack has been depleted and the Yakima Basin went on storage control on May 21st. The May pro-rationing set by the Bureau of Reclamation is 52% supply to prorated water rights. SDBOC is currently diverting 810 cfs.

Mr. Cowin presented the ELIPS Material bid. Six bids were received by Ferguson - Pasco, Core & Main - Pasco, HD Fowler - Yakima, Lad Irrigation - Pasco, K & D Machine - Grandview, and Orchard and Vineyard Supply - Pasco. The low bid for Schedules A and D were submitted by Core & Main in the total amount of \$502,057.58. The low bids for Schedule B was submitted by Orchard and Vineyard Supply in the amount of \$55,481.40. The low bid for Schedule C was submitted by Ferguson Waterworks in the amount of \$69,047.20. The low bid for Schedule E was submitted by HD Fowler in the amount of \$11,569.50. A motion was made by Director Rollinger which was seconded and unanimously carried, authorizing the award of the bid schedules listed above. The bid summary is attached and by this reference incorporated into these minutes.

Mr. Felman reported that the Department of Ecology responded to the May 1, 2026, letter. No operational changes are planned, and the Department continues to state that it is too early to determine whether senior water right holders will be curtailed in October.

At 1:45 PM Chairman Simpson announced the Board would convene into Executive Session pursuant to RCW 42.30.110(1)(i) to last until 2:00 PM. The purpose of the executive session was to discuss litigation or potential litigation involving or likely to involve the District as a party. At 2:00 PM, Chairman Simpson announced a 20-minute extension to be concluded at 2:20 PM.

At 2:20 the Board reconvened into open session.

Following reconvening, a motion was made by Director Scarlett which was seconded and unanimously carried, authorizing the Board Chairman to sign onto a joint response letter to the Department of Ecology pending final revisions and coordination with other Senior Coalition members.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:25 PM.
